Goods In / Out:

- Accurate recording of goods in and out using Sage and carry out visual checks using kit lists provided
- Identify and record shortages and notify your supervisor
- Assist with weekly stock count
- Ensure parts are correctly labelled prior to being moved to other sites
- Assist in the loading / unloading of goods, ensuring safe working practices are adhered to at all times
- Effective communication with production and management regarding the receipt and despatch of goods
- Carry out an inspection of all goods

Yard Duties:

- Adhere to health & safety standards in the yard and onsite
- Report health & safety breaches to your supervisor
- Ensure the yard is clean, tidy and well maintained and escalate any issues to your supervisor
- Ensure walkways are kept clear and in a safe condition
